Day 1: An Infinite Love

Day 2: A Steadfast Love

But He is love & He is unchanging, dependable, faithful... It's not based on anything you do, but simply on who He is, so rest in His love today.

Day 6: An Authentic Love

God gave us the power to become sons, the bible says we have received His Spirit of adoption whereby we can cry Abba Father. We are loved the same way Christ is, but this also means we will be corrected & disciplined as His sons. He receives us as we are and through our obedience He produces the Character of Christ in us. He is not a harsh taskmaster but a loving Father who wants to see His sons rising up to be and do all that He prepared for them in advance. If we really want to believe & receive the Love of God into our hearts then let us not expect it to be without pruning & correction. An authentic love says no sometimes, tells you when and why you are wrong, shows you how to correct your mistakes, convicts you of sin & helps you to conquer it, and pushes you forwards to maturity in all things. Just like our natural parents correct us, God leads us in paths of righteousness as He disciplines us. Do not be discouraged at His rebuke, for it is the surest sign of His love in action, calling us to come up higher in Him.

Scripture refs/focus: John 1:12 KJV | Hebrews 12:5-9 | Romans 8:15, 29.
