Day 1: Christ is Enough

Christ is your desperate need; no material thing will fill the void & no human can fully satisfy your need for security & significance. He completes us.

Whatever you are facing today, know that because you have Christ, you have all you need. Lean on His faithfulness today, lean on His abundance...He cannot let you down.

Scripture:

John 4:14 "but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him as fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

Application: Refresh yourself at the Well of Life today. His Well never runs dry, and will satisfy your thirst. Drink Him in.

Reflect: Is there any area in this season where you feel discontent or incomplete? Pour this out to Daddy God and believe by faith that in Christ you are whole, and able to learn contentment. Why not find a scripture or two that speak to you personally to meditate on?

Run the race & do not grow faint, knowing that is not in vain, you are running for an eternal prize... To live with Him in eternity. Keep pressing onwards.

Day 2: Christ the Eternal Prize

Keep going and stay focused on what God is asking of you -eyes on Him. He is your exceedingly great reward (Gen 15:1)

Eternity with Him is the promise that gets you out of bed every day, loving and serving others under the leadership of The Holy Spirit. Don't give up because of what others may or may not say or think. Know that you are storing up treasures in Heaven as you keep running in obedience.

Scriptures:

Philippians 3:13-15 ¹³Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, ¹⁴I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call

of God in Christ Jesus. ¹⁵Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind; and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal even this to you.

Colossians 3:1-4 ¹If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. ²Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. ³For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴When Christ *who is* our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

Day 3: Married to Christ ❤️

We pray against every spirit of loneliness, depression & discontentment this morning in the name of Jesus! You are a friend of God! He IS the comforter; He is the friend that sticks closer than a brother. Your first ministry is a marriage to Him; your true fellowship is with Him & the Father by His Spirit... Desiring marriage is not wrong, it is in fact a godly desire, but don't allow seeds of discontentment to settle in your heart to the point of coveting.

Do you know Him intimately? Remembering His words in Matthew 7:21-13 ~"Not everyone who says to Me 'Lord, Lord,'.... An earthly marriage should be a reflection of our relationship with Christ, learn to love by loving, worshipping, serving & submitting to Christ first. If you don't know where

to start, start by being His friend...Why not hang out in His presence today, with no agenda but to be with Him.

Scriptures:

Ephesians 5:26-30 ²⁶ that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. ²⁸ So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. ²⁹ For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord *does* the church. ³⁰ For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones.

Colossians 3:23-24 ²³ And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, ²⁴ knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

Scriptures:

John 14:27 (Amp) ²⁷ Peace I leave with you; My [own] peace I now give *and* bequeath to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let

them be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.]

Philippians 4:6 ⁶ Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

Day 6: Christ our Freedom ❤️

Christ purchased our freedom at the cost of His life, for us to be completely free to live an abundant life of worship & obedience to God, prospering even as our soul prospers. Don't settle. Press in for complete freedom.

Scriptures:

John 10:10 ¹⁰The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

3 John 1:2 ²Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.

1 John 1:9 ⁹If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
